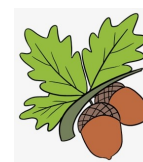

Health guidelines for worship at Groffdale Mennonite Church Sunday, October 25, 2020

We are so grateful for the spirit of cooperation and teamwork we are experiencing as we gather for worship! Thank you for the inconveniences and sacrifices everyone is making so that we can be together. Let's continue to seek God's wisdom and protection.

- Please wear masks whenever you aren't seated in the auditorium and while singing.
- If you prefer to take your mask off while seated for worship, we request that you sit on the sewing room side of the church.
- If you are willing to wear a mask while seated in the auditorium, please sit on the piano side of the church.
- We request that you sit in every other bench to allow for appropriate distancing and to allow at least six feet between household units when seated. (Benches are taped accordingly.) Ushers will be available to assist you.
- We are live streaming the worship service to the all-purpose room for those who prefer the safest environment. (Masks required by everyone at all times in the all-purpose room.)
- After church, let's try as much as possible to not congregate in crowded areas and to maintain distancing of six feet or more. Be attentive to moving conversations outside if you're able or to more open areas.

GriefShare: Surviving the Holidays', a two-hour seminar providing help in dealing with the hurt of grief and loss. This event will be held on Sunday, November 15, 2020 from 2-4:00 p.m. at Ephrata Bible Fellowship Church, 491 Peach Road, Ephrata. Those who attend will receive a free book providing insights and ideas on holiday survival. There is no charge for this event.

The seminar features practical suggestions and reassurance through video interviews with counselors, grief experts and other people who have experienced the holidays after their loved one's death. Topics discussed include "Why the Holidays Are Tough," "What to Expect," "How to Prepare," "How to Manage Relationships and Holiday Socials" and "Using the Holidays to Help You Heal."
