# MENNONITE CHILDREN'S CHOIR AUDITIONS

The Mennonite Children's Choir of Lancaster is holding auditions for the 2018-2019 choir year on June 11 at Blossom Hill Mennonite Church, <u>333</u> <u>Delp Road, Lancaster</u>. Auditions include matching pitch, singing in



tune, using head voice, maintaining a melodic line while another line is being sung and singing one prepared piece of music.

The choir involves singers in Carol Choir, grades 2-5; Concert Choir, grades 6-8; and Chamber Choir, grades 9-12. The choirs practice weekly throughout the school year in preparation for a concert series in early December and in the spring. Singers rehearse Tuesday evenings January through April.
