Contents (NEW items only)

- □ 3 spools white thread (all-purpose; cotton/poly or 100% polyester; minimum 250 yards.)
- □ **3 spools black thread** (all-purpose; cotton/poly or 100% polyester; minimum 250 yards.)
- □ 1 metric fabric tape measure (plastic or fiberglass; 150 cm; inch marking optional)
- □ 1 thimble (metal; medium size)
- □ 1 dressmaker shears (good quality)
- □ 1 package needles (minimum 25; assorted sizes)
- □ 1 package straight pins (minimum 80; round plastic heads preferred)
- □ Shirt-style buttons (12; black or white; size 1/2—1 inch; place loose buttons in a resealable plastic bag)
- □ **Sew-on snaps** (minimum 20; assorted sizes)
- □ Safety pins (minimum 10; assorted sizes)
