

Sermon series from Jude

This morning we continue our sermon series from Jude, one of the shortest and most neglected books in the New Testament. Jude's letter warns about false teachers who distort the grace of God, but it also proclaims a beautiful message of mercy and grace. Today we look at Jude's call for mercy toward those who doubt or are enticed by sin. Jude warns of the danger of false teaching that leads to disobedience, but he also exhorts his readers to a posture of hopeful mercy toward those led astray. Each of us know people who have wandered from or who have rejected faith in Christ. Jude reminds us to persevere with mercy toward those who struggle and waver. As we ourselves depend each day on Christ's mercy, so God calls us to a posture of compassion and hopeful perseverance.
