

This Sunday we begin a series re-telling the story of the early Anabaptists who were willing to risk everything and die as martyrs as an expression of their love for Jesus. This morning we'll remember the winter Zurich night in 1525 when George Blaurock asked his friend Conrad Grebel to baptize him. Next Sunday we'll tell the story of Michael and Margaretta Sattler. These are stories of men and women who struggled, searched, and found a faith in Christ that transformed their lives and made them willing to forsake status, comfort and security in obedience to their Lord Jesus.
